How do I enroll in the coverage?

Students can enroll online at www.insuranceforstudents.com/mdc by entering their date of birth and selecting "enroll". Students may also enroll by mailing a completed enrollment form & payment to the address at the bottom of the enrollment form.

How do I receive my Medical ID Card?

You will receive a Welcome Email from UnitedHealthcare Student Health with information on creating a UHCSR online account. Make sure to keep a copy of your id card in your wallet and take a picture of the front and back of your id card with your phone.
